Are you interested in serving on a standing committee of the Pennsylvania Public Transportation Association? Some committees are responsible for the organizational and operating procedures of PPTA, while others study and recommend policy and action on a particular Association program or service. The Association's program of work and fiscal year is July 1 – June 30. Most committees meet 2 to 4 times a year. Committee business is conducted by meetings and/or conference calls. Individuals serve for one year, and there is no maximum number of members for any committee.

Community Transportation Committee

To provide support to human service transportation systems through information sharing, peer discussion, networking and to collectively advocate on behalf of human service transportation

Financial Officers Committee

The Finance Committee promotes best practices among members and communicates information. Reviews concerns about transit agency finances and works with members to resolve these concerns or find out who can help.

Human Resources Committee

By providing a forum that promotes leadership, collaboration, an innovation, the Human Resources Committee helps public transportation professionals at all levels interested in workforce development, human resources and labor relations to recruit, develop and maintain a high performing and diverse workforce and fosters a healthy, safe and productive work force and environment for our employees and the public and positions public transportation providers in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as an employer of choice.

Maintenance Committee

Offers ideas and suggestions for the improvements to current practices and procedures. Communicates information and share experiences among PPTA member agency's maintenance staff and vendors. Reviews concerns about transit agency maintenance.

Marketing & Communications Committee

Dedicated to assisting and enabling members to understand and pursue effective public relations and marketing practices for the benefit of their individual properties and the association as a whole. Provides feedback and insight into the needs for PPTA marketing activities. Works in conjunction with other PPTA committees to increase public awareness of the association and the PPTA mission.

Operations Committee

Promotes the standards within the Commonwealth by coordinating efforts and best practices in order to meet the standards required by DOT and FTA regulations, and to plan, organize and conduct the Annual Rodeo competition.

Planning Committee

The purpose and mission of the PPTA Planning Committee is to support coordination, sharing lessons learned and best practices related to transit planning.

Ride Share Committee

The PPTA Rideshare Committee's objective is to successfully create awareness that ridesharing is a complementary, not competitive, service to all modes of transportation; and to maximize resources to produce the best economical choices to commuters.

Safety Committee

The committee scope includes all aspects of transit bus operational safety including operator training and safety supervision. Members of this committee include Safety Officers, Risk Managers, Transportation & Maintenance Supervisors, Union Officers, Bus Operators, and others with an interest in improving Bus Safety.
