



DIRECTOR OF MAINTENANCE

AMTRAN (Altoona, PA) is seeking a Director of Maintenance. This position will work closely with the Chief Executive Officer and Senior Management staff to manage the public transportation needs of a 26 fixed-route bus fleet operation and a maintenance staff of eight (8).

The essential function of the position is to provide safe, efficient, and clean vehicles for the customers in the safest and most cost-effective manner possible. This position is responsible for overall vehicle maintenance as well as facility and grounds maintenance along with the purchase of vehicle parts and supplies for the Authority. Responsibilities include managing, planning, and supervising the daily maintenance activities of the AMTRAN system which operates six days a week. The position is also responsible for overseeing the safety and training programs of the maintenance staff with the goal of advancing the technical skill level of all maintenance employees.

The position requires proven skills in management, administration, and transit maintenance, including knowledge of the principles and practices governing the operation and maintenance of a public transit system; demonstrated ability to manage, plan and supervise the work of others; demonstrated ability to establish and maintain good employee and public relations, computer skills. Excellent verbal and written communication skills are a must. Qualified candidates will possess at minimum a high school diploma or its equivalent. Technical education in or extensive work experience in heavy-duty vehicle maintenance is required. Must possess a PA State Inspection license for larger vehicles.
